- Upper Wacker Drive (*Michigan Avenue to east turnaround*)

Closed 5:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m. on Saturday, November 18

- Upper Columbus (*Wacker Drive to Randolph*)

ADDITIONAL STREET CLOSURES:

Closed 8 a.m. – 6 p.m. on Saturday, November 18

- Clark Street (*East curb lane only Oak Street to Delaware Street*)
- Delaware Street (*Dearborn Street to Clark Street north curb lane only*)
- Oak Street (*Clark Street to State Street*)
- Dearborn Street (*Delaware Street to Maple Street*)
- Walton Street (*State Street to Clark Street*)

Closed 3:30 p.m. – 9 p.m. on Saturday, November 18

- Upper Columbus (*Curb lanes from Wacker Drive to Randolph Street*)
- Randolph Street (*Curb lanes from Michigan to Columbus*)
